

PAVRO Standardized Volunteer Opinion Survey - Sample Questions

The SVOS consists of forty-two questions that are designed to assess a variety of areas within the context of 7 survey dimensions: volunteer experience, orientation, recognition, learning environment, teamwork, patient safety, and general safety. There are five demographic questions. Questions are either in a rating scale format or free text allowing for comments and input by respondents.

The final report provides a summary of the results of each question and survey topic/dimension. Individual hospital/heathcare centre results as well as group averages are presented. High performers are identified for each topic/dimension. Each organization receives an individual report as well as an excel spreadsheet report which can be customized to support presentations of individual data and results along with comparisons to other organizations.

The information below provides sample questions from each survey dimension.
